The Common Council of the City of New Haven, Indiana, met at the City Administration Building on the 20th day of October at the hour of 7:00 p.m. in a regular session in accordance with the rules of the Council.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve McMichael who presided.

Mike Clendenen, Superintendent of Parks & Recreation New Haven-Adams Township, stated that he is excited to see this park come together. This park has a lot of opportunities for everyone in the community. Stacey McDaniel, 1506 Woodmere Drive, stated that she is the Meadowbrook Association president, and she is concerned that the park they have will be forgotten. She stated children in the neighborhood use the park frequently. Second call with no comments. Third and final call with no comments. Terry Werling, Councilman at Large, asked if there would be sand volleyball courts. Nathan Dieg, from Jones Petrie Rafinski, answered that after the neighborhood was surveyed, sand volleyball courts did not rank very high on priorities. Craig Dellinger declared the public hearing closed.

Under new business Item B was a vote of confidence for the Fire Territory with City of Woodburn, Maumee Township, Adams Township, Jefferson Township and Milan Center Township. The territory will be able to hire a Fire Inspector and have paramedics in other townships. The territory will keep the pay rate equal across the townships and cities.
